Yes, it is Book Week time yet again, with celebrations commencing soon (Tuesday 22 August) and revolving around the theme 'Escape to Everywhere'.

This fantastic theme allows students to explore the endless possibilities about where and when books can be read and enjoyed.

Activities this year will be:

• Dress up as your favourite book character YEAR 6 STUDENTS ONLY:

This year on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August, students in YEAR 6 are invited to come dressed up as their favourite book character. This is not a competition to see who is the 'best dressed' but merely another fun activity to celebrate Book Week. We will have a small parade under the COLA at 9.30ish so we can have a look at everyone's fabulous creations! Parents, grandparents and friends are most welcome to attend. If possible, could students please bring along a copy of the book their character comes from. (At Exeter PS we traditionally only dress up every alternate year but Year 6 have asked if they can dress up this year as it is their final Book Week in Primary school!)

• Picnic with Parents, Grandparents, friends:

Parents, grandparents, friends are invited to join us for lunch on Thursday 24th August. Bring along a picnic and a picnic blanket and enjoy having lunch with your children. Take a book outside and share your favourite story together - 'Escape to Everywhere' with a book. Parents and grandparents who show their enjoyment of reading encourages their children/grandchildren to participate in this worthwhile activity too.

• Scholastic Book Fair:

Scholastic Book Fairs will be providing the books for the fair which will be on display in the Library on Wednesday 23rd & Thursday 24th August. Children will be allowed to look at the books during lunchtime each day and will complete a 'wish list' prior to the purchase date. The books available for purchase are of high quality and are reasonably priced. In addition to this, 10-20% of the total price of all books purchased will be paid to the school as commission for the purchase of more books for the classroom and Library.
